ORDINANCE # 082

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HAVEN, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR A CALENDAR YEAR 2014 TAX RATE OF 0.1125 / \$100 OF APPRAISED PROPERTY VALUE AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Whereas, the City of Highland Haven, Texas depends on property taxes to obtain income for necessary operating expenses; and

Whereas, the City is authorized by the State of Texas to assess property taxes for such purpose; and

Whereas, the cost for fire protection and first responder services has increased significantly; and

Whereas, the proposed fiscal year 2015 budget requires a property tax rate of \$0.1125 / \$100 of appraised value for calendar year 2014, and the calendar 2013 tax rate was \$0.1125 / \$100; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HAVEN, TEXAS THAT:

The property tax rate for the year 2014 for the City is set at \$0.1125 per \$100.00 of appraised property value.

This tax rate will raise more taxes for maintenance and operations than last year's tax rate. The tax rate will effectively be raised 1.17% and will raise taxes for maintenance and operations on a \$100,000 home by approximately \$21.10.

Section 1. <u>Authorization</u> - The Burnet Central Appraisal District is authorized to collect taxes for the City of Highland Haven, Texas for calendar year 2014 at the rate of \$0.1125 / \$100 of appraised valuation.

Section 2. <u>Application</u> - This Ordinance applies to all property located within the city limits of Highland Haven, Texas as shown on the Burnet County Appraisal District 2014 property tax roll.
