Contribute to the Burnet County Recycle Project

Whereas, The LCRA will no longer sponsor an annual hazardous materials collection program and

Whereas Burnet County is organizing a substitute hazardous material collection headed by Marble Falls Fire Chief Larry Wright and

Whereas, a grant of \$13,000 has been requested from the Capital Area Council of Governments to partially fund the project and

Whereas, Burnet County Cities will contribute \$1,500 each to the project and

Whereas, there will be two pickup drop-off areas in the county, one in the northern and one in the southern parts of Burnet County.

Be it therefore resolved, that the Board of Aldermen of the City of Highland Haven, Texas, hereby authorize a contribution of \$500 to the Burnet County hazardous materials collection program.
