ORDINANCE #045

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HAVEN, TEXAS, CERTIFYING THAT THE THREE QUALIFIED CITIZENS WHO FILED FOR THE VACANT POSITIONS ON THE 2004 ELECTION BALLOT WERE UNOPPOSED AND ARE THEREFORE ELECTED TO THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN AND THE POSITION OF MAYOR.

WHEREAS, two positions on the Board of Aldermen and the office of Mayor were to be filled during the May 15, 2004 election; and

WHEREAS, three qualified citizens filed for these positions on the ballot for the May 15, 2004 election; and

WHEREAS, the election official for the City of Highland Haven, Texas has furnished written certification of the unopposed status of the three qualified citizens that filed for a position on the May 2004 election ballot, and

WHEREAS, the Texas Election Code Section §2.053 (a) authorizes the Board of Aldermen of the City of Highland Haven, Texas to declare each unopposed candidate elected to office when the number of qualified citizens filing for a position on the ballot equals the number of vacancies to be filled.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HAVEN, TEXAS.

That the three qualified citizens, Roscoe Holt, Mayor and Stephen O'Malley and Peter Freehill as Aldermen are elected to the above positions in the City of Highland Haven, Texas effective May 15, 2004.

PASSED AND APPROVED this the 20th day of April 2004 by a yes vote of 5 and a no vote of 0.
