ORDINANCE # 072

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HAVEN, TEXAS, CERTIFYING THAT THE TWO QUALIFIED CITIZENS WHO FILED FOR THE VACANT POSITIONS ON THE MAY 8, 2010 ELECTION BALLOT WERE UNOPPOSED AND ARE THEREFORE ELECTED ALDERMEN.

WHEREAS, two positions on the Board of Aldermen were to be filled during the May 8, 2010 election; and

WHEREAS, two qualified citizens filed for these positions on the ballot for the May 8, 2010 election; and

WHEREAS, the election official for the City of Highland Haven, Texas furnished written notice of the unopposed status of the two qualified citizens that filed for a position on the May 8, 2010 election ballot, and

WHEREAS, the Texas Election Code Section §2.053 (a) authorizes the Board of Aldermen of the City of Highland Haven, Texas to declare each unopposed candidate elected to office when the number of qualified citizens filing for a position on the ballot equals the number of vacancies to be filled.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HAVEN, TEXAS.

That the two qualified citizens, Angelo Anzivino and Jim Holgate are elected to the positions of Aldermen in the City of Highland Haven, Texas effective May 18, 2010.
