RESOLUTION #094

WHEREAS, the subdivision of Highland Haven was established on or about August 8, 1962; and

WHEREAS, the subdivision plats of the various sections of the subdivision of Highland Haven recorded at various times between 1962 and 1969 did purport to dedicate the streets, alley and passageways to the use of the public; and

WHEREAS, at no time did the County of Burnet of the State of Texas ever accept for maintenance or control the streets, except County Road 125, located within the said City of Highland Haven; and

WHEREAS, before the incorporation of Highland Haven, the Highland Haven Property Owners Association of the same entity began assessing and collecting dues for the maintenance of the said streets of the subdivision pursuant to rights granted to the said association by the recorded Declaration and Restrictions related to the subdivision; and

WHEREAS, on the 5th day of November, 1995, the citizens of the community voted to incorporate the community, including all of Highland Haven subdivision, into the City of Highland Haven, Texas, and from that date on the said city of Highland Haven did accept the responsibility of control and maintenance of the public streets and passageways within the boundaries of the City, except for County Road 125, and;

NOW WHEREFORE THE SAID PREMISES CONSIDERED, ACCEPTED AND APPROVED, it is hereby resolved by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Highland Haven, Texas that upon the date of incorporation of the City of Highland Haven, Texas that the city did accept and undertake the control and maintenance for all public streets and rights of way located within the boundaries of the City of Highland Haven, Texas, except County Road 125, from that day forward.
