RESOLUTION #284

January 21, 2014

Approve in principle transferring the Nobles Subdivision from the Granite Shoals Extra-territorial Jurisdiction (ETJ) to the Highland Haven ETJ.

Whereas, the Nobles Subdivision is now in the Granite Shoals ETJ, and;

Whereas the Nobles Subdivision is located immediately adjacent to the City of Highland Haven and,

Whereas, the Nobles Subdivision is not connected by land to the City of Granite Shoals and,

Whereas, the Nobles Subdivision and Highland Haven share a common access road and a common boundary and,

Whereas, the City of Highland Haven would prefer to regulate infrastructure and subdivision development in the Nobles Subdivision.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the Board of Aldermen of the City of Highland Haven, Texas, approve in principle the transfer of the Nobles Subdivision from the Granite Shoals ETJ to the Highland Haven ETJ. Providing the City of Granite Shoals also approves in principle to the ETJ transfer, the city is authorized to negotiate the ETJ transfer with the City of Granite Shoals. The ETJ transfer is then subject to final approval of the City of Granite Shoals and the Board of Aldermen of the City of Highland Haven.
